For those who value our Post, please step up into an Officer position in your respective organization to help provide input into the direction of our operations. There are many verbal suggestions that come to the existing leadership that would have more of a chance of being successful if there were volunteers coming along to support implementing the suggestions. 



BAR TALK



One of the current topics of discussion has been why we switched to cans and whether we will switch back to bottles. Due to supply and demand issues under Covid, we started receiving cans in addition to bottles and in the fourth quarter of 2020 fully switched to cans to review if there was a cost benefit to lower prices and keep cans only. While there was a cost savings to carry cans, the savings was not enough to cover the cost of lowering the sell price by 25 cents. The savings did allow for the extension of the "bucket of beer" specials during games to Monday and Thursday games in addition to Sunday as the cost of selling five beer cans at a discount was covered. In addition to extending bucket sales, it has been evaluated to bring a sports package in for the games that we currently cannot get with Empire Access, which would be covered with the continuance of purchasing cans versus bottles. While there are those who prefer to have bottles, there are just as many who desire the sports package and extra days of bucket sales, and the decision lies with the Board of Directors to continue with cans or switch back to bottles with no sports package or extra days of buckets.
